- Michael E. Douglas joined Southeast Alaska Regional Health Consortium (SEARHC) as general counsel in November 2012 after having served six months as interim-general counsel. He was promoted to vice president, chief legal officer in January 2015 and became senior vice president, chief legal officer in August 2020.
- Mr. Douglas holds a Master of Science in Health Care Delivery (with concentrations in innovation, finance, leadership and healthcare management) from the Tuck School of Business and Geisel School of Medicine at Dartmouth College. He received a Juris Doctor from the University of Washington School of Law, and a Bachelor of Arts with an Interdisciplinary Concentration in Law & Diversity from Fairhaven College at Western Washington University.
- Prior to his tenure at SEARHC, Mr. Douglas practiced for five years as an associate attorney with the Indian law firm of Sonosky, Chambers, Sachse, Miller & Munson, LLP, in Anchorage and Juneau. He also served as law clerk for The Hon. Trevor N. Stephens in the Superior Court for the State of Alaska, First Judicial District at Ketchikan. Mr. Douglas is admitted to practice in Alaska and Washington, and before the U.S. District Court for the District of Alaska and the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit.
- Mr. Douglas is *Haida*. He is enrolled with the Central Council Tlingit and Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska and his family originates from Hydaburg, AK.
