- H.R. 6181 [Discussion Draft ANS to H.R. 6181 attached] (Rep. Ruben Gallego, D-AZ), To reaffirm that certain land has been taken into trust for the benefit of the Samish Indian Nation, and for other purposes. "Samish Indian Nation Land Reaffirmation Act."
- <u>S. 314</u> (Sen. Jeff Merkley, D-OR), To repeal the Klamath Tribe Judgment Fund Act. "*Klamath Tribe Judgment Fund Repeal Act.*"
- <u>S. 559</u> (Sen. Jeff Merkley, D-OR), To amend the Grand Ronde Reservation Act, and for other purposes.
- <u>S. 789</u> (Sen. Mike Rounds, R-SD), To repeal certain obsolete laws relating to Indians. "Repealing Existing Substandard Provisions Encouraging Conciliation with Tribes Act."
