My name is Johnni Belle Miller birth last name George I am Survivor of Indian boarding school the ran by the government intermountain in Utah. My father Neil Evans George was a survivor residential school in Hoopa cal and then Sherman residential in California the scars and the abuse that he suffered along with my aunts and uncles are unforgivable this is all done in the name of God and was approved by the government the loss of our culture is inexcusable our tribe Karuk was one of the main tribes in California. My father aunts and uncles never got over the punishment and the torture rape molestation starvation and mental abuse they all later in life were alcoholics my father became clean at the age of 45 which point he had had me but the trauma was still there and passed to me which I passed to my children I sit here today and have much more to say about the situation considering it's an email please let it be known I am here to answer any questions and get further information that I am aware of on my father aunts and uncles we are still here we are still suffering today because of these atrocious acts. The slogan killed the Indian save the child should never have been you did more than kill the Indian you try to take our culture away from us and punish us for being who we are said we were the savages in reality the church and the government were the savages Thank you Johnni Miller
