I am the baby of the family, but my Brother and Sister were raised by him. He tortured them to learn their address the same way the Indian School taught him. TORTURED. As we read more elders stories of Indian Schools, we began to realize this is what tortured our Father his entire life. We began to heal and understand him. It is so important that the truth come out. There must be truth or there is no healing.
