Under the Puerto Rico Transmission and Distribution Operation and Maintenance Agreement dated June 22, 2020 (“T&D OMA”), LUMA Energy, LLC and LUMA Energy ServCo, LLC (together “LUMA”) is the Operator of the T&D System in Puerto Rico and as such carries out specific O&M Services in relation to the T&D System owned by the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority.

The Federal Energy Management Agency (“FEMA”) under DR-4339-PR and DR-4671-PR is funding repairs and reconstruction of the electric grid in Puerto Rico. LUMA acts as agent of PREPA in connection with any federal funding requests related to the T&D System. To date, LUMA has initiated 460 projects to FEMA representing \$12.3 billion in federal funding.

In addition, the Department of Energy recently awarded Grant Number GD0000055 for LUMA’s Customer Battery Energy Sharing (CBES) pilot project. The award value is \$3.5 million.

In addition, LUMA participates in projects and otherwise works with partners who receive funding from the Federal government on a variety of projects that benefit the electric grid.
