

Councilwoman Victoria “Tori” Kitcheyan was first elected to the Winnebago Tribal Council in 2015. From October 2020 to October 2025, she served as the Tribal Chairwoman.

Kitcheyan is the former Chairwoman of the National Indian Health Board (NIHB), the Secretary’s Tribal Advisory Committee (STAC) at the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, and the Medicare, Medicaid, and Health Reform Policy Committee (MMPC). She has also served on various Tribal technical advisory committees for the Great Plains area.

She has testified numerous times before the U.S. House of Representatives and the U.S. Senate on issues including health care disparities in Indian Country, Tribal land consolidation, advance appropriations for Indian programs, and Tribal infrastructure needs. Kitcheyan holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Administration from Haskell Indian Nations University.
