



**Charles R. Paul**  
**Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary**  
**to the United States of America**

H.E. Charles R. Paul is the fifth Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of Republic of the Marshall Islands to the United States of America. He held the same position from 2011 to 2015, making him also the third RMI Ambassador to the US.

Between his initial appointment and subsequent re-appointment in September 2023, Ambassador Paul held the position of Advisor to the Executive Director at the World Bank Group from June 2015 to June 2017. Following this role, he co-founded a real estate financial firm in 2017.

Before his initial appointment, Ambassador Paul held several key positions within the RMI Government, including Deputy Chief of Mission at the RMI Embassy in the United States and Economic, Performance, and Budgeting Coordinator with the Economic Policy, Planning, and Statistics Office under the Office of the President, among other roles.

Ambassador Paul holds a Masters of Science in Finance, and a Graduate Certificate in Financial Management from Johns Hopkins University, as well as a Bachelor of Arts in Economics from Washington College, Maryland.

Ambassador Paul was born and raised on Ebeye, Kwajalein Atoll, and was among the inaugural participants in the United States Army Kwajalein Atoll “Rikatak” Program. His interests include historical documentaries, sports, and culinary pursuits.
