3 “(B) discourages the charging or prosecu-
4 tion of an individual described in subparagraph
5 (A) for a prostitution or sex trafficking offense,
6 based on the conduct described in subparagraph
7 (A); or

8 “(C) encourages the diversion of an indi-
9 vidual described in subparagraph (A) to appro-
10 priate service providers, including child welfare
11 services, victim treatment programs, child advo-
12 cacy centers, rape crisis centers, or other social
13 services.”; and

14 (2) in section 1709, by inserting at the end the
15 following:

16 “(5) ‘commercial sex act’ has the meaning given
17 the term in section 103 of the Victims of Trafficking
18 and Violence Protection Act of 2000 (22 U.S.C.
19 7102).

20 “(6) ‘minor’ means an individual who has not
21 attained the age of 18 years.

22 “(7) ‘severe form of trafficking in persons’ has
23 the meaning given the term in section 103 of the
24 Victims of Trafficking and Violence Protection Act
25 of 2000 (22 U.S.C. 7102).”.

1 **SEC. 3. REPORT ON RESTITUTION PAID IN CONNECTION**
2 **WITH CERTAIN TRAFFICKING OFFENSES.**

3 Section 105(d)(7)(Q) of the Victims of Trafficking
4 Protection Act of 2000 (22 U.S.C. 7103(d)(7)(Q)) is
5 amended—

6 (1) by inserting after “1590,” the following:
7 “1591,”;

8 (2) by striking “and 1594” and inserting
9 “1594, 2422, and 2423”;

10 (3) in clause (iv), by striking “and” at the end;
11 and

12 (4) by inserting after clause (v) the following:

13 “(vi) the number of individuals re-
14 quired by a court order to pay restitution
15 in connection with a violation of each of-
16 fense under title 18, United States Code,
17 the amount of restitution required to be
18 paid under each such order, and the
19 amount of restitution actually paid pursu-
20 ant to each such order; and”.

21 **SEC. 4. NATIONAL HUMAN TRAFFICKING HOTLINE.**

22 Section 107(b)(2) of the Victims of Trafficking and
23 Violence Protection Act of 2000 (22 U.S.C. 7105(b)(2))
24 is amended—

25 (1) by redesignating subparagraphs (B) and
26 (C) as subparagraphs (C) and (D), respectively; and

1 (2) by inserting after subparagraph (A) the fol-
2 lowing:

3 “(B) NATIONAL HUMAN TRAFFICKING
4 HOTLINE.—Beginning in fiscal year 2017 and
5 each fiscal year thereafter, of amounts made
6 available for grants under this paragraph, the
7 Secretary of Health and Human Services shall
8 make grants for a national communication sys-
9 tem to assist victims of severe forms of traf-
10 ficking in persons in communicating with serv-
11 ice providers. The Secretary shall give priority
12 to grant applicants that have experience in pro-
13 viding telephone services to victims of severe
14 forms of trafficking in persons.”.

15 **SEC. 5. JOB CORPS ELIGIBILITY.**

16 Section 144(3) of the Workforce Investment Act of
17 1998 (29 U.S.C. 2884(3)) is amended by adding at the
18 end the following:

19 “(F) A victim of a severe form of traf-
20 ficking in persons (as defined in section 103 of
21 the Victims of Trafficking and Violence Protec-
22 tion Act of 2000 (22 U.S.C. 7102)). Notwith-
23 standing paragraph (2), an individual described

1 in this subparagraph shall not be required to
2 demonstrate eligibility under such paragraph.”.
