

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1689**  
**OFFERED BY MR. NADLER OF NEW YORK**

Page 1, line 8, strike “(a) IN GENERAL.—”.

Page 2, strike line 6 and all that follows through page 3, line 3.

Page 3, beginning on line 24, strike “an appropriate relief” through page 4, line 2, and insert “equitable relief and compensatory damages”.

Page 4, line 6, strike “following the conclusion” and insert “upon the commencement”.

Page 6, line 17, strike “relief” and all that follows through line 18 and insert “equitable relief.”.

Page 6, line 22, strike “following the conclusion” and insert “upon the commencement”.

Page 9, strike lines 12 through 18 and insert the following:

- 1           (5) identify the final disposition of each action
- 2           and report identified in paragraphs (1), (2), (3), and
- 3           (4), including the name of the State or political sub-
- 4           division, and the amount of damages and attorneys
- 5           fees awarded.

Page 12, strike line 20 and all that follows through page 13, line 7, and insert the following:

1       (b) RELIEF AVAILABLE FOR RELIGIOUS AND NON-  
2 PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS.—A religious or nonprofit organi-  
3 zation may seek relief for a violation of this Act as pro-  
4 vided in section 4 of this Act.
