

**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE
NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 7694
OFFERED BY M . _____**

Page 1, insert after line 3 the following (and redesignate succeeding sections accordingly):

1 SEC. 2. FINDINGS.

2 The Congress finds as follows:

3 (1) The Obama-Biden Administration sought to
4 sabotage the Trump transition by illegally spying on
5 the Trump campaign, unmasking members of the
6 Trump campaign, and employing aggressive and co-
7 ercive tactics on Trump campaign officials.

8 (2) Attorney General William P. Barr is fixing
9 the abuses and errors of the Obama-Biden Depart-
10 ment of Justice (DOJ) and the Special Counsel in
11 its politicized investigations.

12 (3) The aggressive treatment of Trump cam-
13 paign aide Roger Stone stands in stark contrast to
14 the treatment of former Obama-Biden officials.

15 (4) Former Federal Bureau of Investigations
16 (FBI) Deputy Director Andrew McCabe violated
17 federal statutes pertaining to false statements, in-
18 cluding the following:

1 (A) According to Justice Department In-
2 spector General Michael Horowitz, McCabe lied
3 to federal investigators multiple times.

4 (B) Horowitz referred McCabe for federal
5 criminal prosecution. The Justice Department,
6 however, declined to prosecute McCabe.

7 (5) Former FBI Director James Comey leaked
8 his conversations with President Trump to spur the
9 Special Counsel investigation. The DOJ Office of In-
10 spector General (OIG) found Comey's conduct so
11 egregious that it criminally referred Comey for pros-
12 ecution. The DOJ OIG strongly criticized Comey for
13 orchestrating the leak of the contents of his memo-
14 randum from his call with President Trump. It con-
15 cluded that Comey "set a dangerous example for the
16 over 35,000 current FBI employees—and the many
17 thousands more former employees". The DOJ OIG
18 condemned Comey for putting his own "personal
19 conception" over Department policies and rules, to
20 achieve a "personally desired outcome". The Justice
21 Department declined to prosecute Comey.

22 (6) The Obama-Biden Justice Department in-
23 vestigated allegations of Trump campaign collusion
24 with Russia in a manner far different than its inves-
25 tigation into Secretary Hillary Clinton's mishandling

1 of classified information. Comey and FBI personnel
2 changed the term “grossly negligent” in the public
3 statement exonerating Secretary Clinton and her
4 aides, so as not to mirror the language in the mis-
5 handling of classified information statute section
6 793(f) of title 18, United States Code. An FBI spe-
7 cial agent perceived that a Clinton aide “lied” dur-
8 ing an interview, yet no criminal charges followed.
9 Attorney General Loretta Lynch instructed Director
10 Comey to refer to the Clinton investigation as a
11 “matter”. Clinton aides received immunity deals
12 during the Clinton email investigation.
