Strike all that follows after the resolving clause and insert the following:

1 That the Secretary of Homeland Security is directed to transmit, to the House of Representatives, not later 2 3 than fourteen days after the date of the adoption of this 4 resolution, copies of any document, memorandum, cor-5 respondence, and other communication, or any portion of any such communication, that refers or relates to impact 6 7 of illegal immigration on Federal or Tribal lands, including the following: 8

9 (1) All documents and communications related
10 to the current level of environmental damage to Fed11 eral protected and Tribal lands along the southern
12 border, including—

13 (A) any reference to an accumulation of14 garbage;

(B) any reference to habitat destruction;
(C) any reference to wildlife deaths; and
(D) any reference to the creation of illegal
trails.

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1	(2) All documents and communications refer-
2	ring or relating to coordinating garbage removal ef-
3	forts along the southern border.
4	(3) All documents and communications refer-
5	ring to the transport of illicit drugs across Federal
6	or Tribal lands, including but not limited to—
7	(A) any reference to Tribal concerns about
8	drug trafficking;
9	(B) any reference to Department of Home-
10	land Security employees' concerns about drug
11	trafficking on Federal lands; and
12	(C) any reference to reports of drug cartels
13	crossing Federal or Tribal lands.
14	(4) Any meeting or communication that oc-
15	curred between Secretary Alejandro Mayorkas, or
16	his representative, with a Tribal representative refer-
17	ring or relating to drug cartel activity on Tribal
18	lands.
19	(5) Any meeting or communication that oc-
20	curred between Secretary Alejandro Mayorkas and
21	Secretary Debra Haaland, or their representatives,
22	referring or relating to drug cartel activity on Fed-
23	eral or Tribal lands.

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
