Page 1, line 12, after the semicolon, insert “or”.

Page 2, line 4, strike “; or” and insert a period.

Page 2, strike lines 5 through 7.

Page 2, line 18, strike “(i), (ii), or (iii)” and insert  
“(i) or (ii)”.

Page 3, strike lines 3 through 9 and insert the fol-  
lowing:

Page 3, after line 9, insert the following:

3           (c) GAO STUDY; REPORT TO CONGRESS.—  
4           (1) STUDY.—Within 1 year after the date of  
5           the enactment of this Act, the Comptroller General  
6           shall conduct a study of the effects of enacting a  
7           residency provision that would allow an individual  
8           who does not have a physical residence in any State  
9           to be able to receive a firearm in the State in which

1 an individual maintains a private mailbox or post of-  
2 fice box. The study shall include an assessment of—

3 (A) how many citizens and lawful residents  
4 of the United States do not have a physical res-  
5 idence in any State;

6 (B) how many firearm transfers are denied  
7 due to the inability of the transferee to estab-  
8 lish residency in any State;

9 (C) how a person could demonstrate to a  
10 Federal firearms licensee that the person does  
11 not have a physical residence in any State;

12 (D) whether such a residency provision  
13 would pose a threat to national security, includ-  
14 ing from foreign or domestic terrorism;

15 (E) whether such a residency provision  
16 would pose a risk of more gun trafficking;

17 (F) whether such a residency provision  
18 would impede effective law enforcement, includ-  
19 ing firearms tracing; and

20 (G) whether such a residency provision  
21 would pose any other risks.

22 (2) REPORT TO CONGRESS.—Within 60 days  
23 after completing the study required by paragraph  
24 (1), the Comptroller General shall prepare and sub-  
25 mit to the Committee on the Judiciary of the House

1 of Representatives and the Committee on the Judici-  
2 ary of the Senate a written report on the findings  
3 of the study.
