

**AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE
TO H.R. 1709
OFFERED BY MR. JORDAN OF OHIO**

Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the following:

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the “Tribal Firearm Access
3 Act of 2024”.

**4 SEC. 2. ALLOWING MEMBERS OF FEDERALLY RECOGNIZED
5 TRIBES TO USE THEIR TRIBAL GOVERNMENT
6 IDENTIFICATION DOCUMENTS IN OBTAINING
7 A FIREARM FROM A FEDERALLY LICENSED
8 FIREARMS DEALER.**

9 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 922(t)(1)(D) of title 18,
10 United States Code, is amended by inserting “, or a valid
11 identification document issued by a Tribal government,”
12 before “of the transferee containing”.

13 (b) DEFINITION.—Section 921(a) of such title is
14 amended by adding at the end the following:

15 “(38) The term ‘Tribal government’ means the recog-
16 nized governing body of any Indian or Alaska Native
17 Tribe, band, nation, pueblo, village, community, compo-
18 nent band, or component reservation, individually identi-

1 fied (including parenthetically) in the list published most
2 recently as of the date of the enactment of this paragraph
3 pursuant to section 104(a) of the Federally Recognized
4 Indian Tribe List Act of 1994 (25 U.S.C. 5131(a)).”.

5 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
6 this section shall take effect on the date that is 90 days
7 after the date of enactment of this Act.
