AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1631

Inserts the following after line 2 on page 9:

SECTION 1. STUDY OF STANDARDS COST TO GOVERNMENTS.

- (a) In General.—The Comptroller General of the United States shall conduct a study on the financial impact to federal, state, and local governments in the United States associated with acquiring access to standards incorporated by reference into law.
- (b) Scope.—The study under subsection (a) shall:
 - (1) Analyze the total expenditure by government entities for accessing these standards;
 - (2) Assess any financial burdens or resource constraints these costs impose on governments, particularly for smaller municipalities; (3) Evaluate the cost-effectiveness of current mechanisms for acquiring these standards; and (4) Examine the impacts on public services due to the costs associated with accessing these standards.
- (c) Report.—Not later than 2 years after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Comptroller General shall submit a report to Congress that includes:
 - (1) The findings of the study conducted under subsection (a); and (2) Recommendations to mitigate any adverse financial impacts identified by the study, including suggestions for legislative or administrative actions as appropriate.
