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1	Α	Yes. Many of the partners that we work with are looking for best practices,	
2	how to mal	ke you know, especially if you need to make a video quickly in a time of	
3	crisis, like,	what are the best ways to do that, best practices around video creation.	
4	That's reall	y what we do.	
5	Q	And because you have that knowledge as a YouTube executive, you were	
6	just trying to help them create something that would be popular on YouTube and easy for		
7	people to f	ind. Is that fair to say?	
8	Α	Easy for people to find and, you know, easily understood in layman's terms	
9	kind of the top of mind questions that laypeople have about what was happening.		
10	Q	Okay. And at any point when you were doing these collaborations with	
11	governmen	t agencies, was the government agency coercing YouTube in any way to	
12	participate in those relationships?		
13	Α	No.	
14	Q	Would you say it was voluntary on the part of YouTube and the government?	
15	Α	Yes. This was our approach across the world was to help health authorities	
16	get the information out there.		
17	Q	And that's because YouTube on its own has identified that mission as	
18	something	that's important to the corporate mission of Google and YouTube?	
19	Α	Yes, that's a top priority.	
20	Q	Okay. And there were times, it appeared, that you interacted more with	
21	NIH and the	e other government agencies, unless, like, the cadence changed over time.	
22	How would you explain that change of interaction or cadence over, say, from 2020 to		
23	2022?		
24	Α	I think just as the you know, as the pandemic evolved initially in 2020,	
25	there was,	you know, an emergent need for information and, you know, a lot of	

1 uncertainty. So, you know, with health authorities in a lot of different countries, I think 2 the cadence was really because of that emergency phase, and then, you know, moved out of the emergency phase to this ongoing mission of raising authoritative health 3 information. 4 5 Q So you were responding to the pandemic itself and the changes that were happening? 6 7 Α Correct. 8 Q Okay. Did any government, U.S. Government agency ever make any 9 demands of you at YouTube in your role at YouTube in terms of, say, like insisting that you prominently display some information from them or anything of that sort? 10 Α No. No. 11 We don't have any further questions.
