OFFERED BY MR. RASKIN OF MARYLAND**

**Substituting text of H.R. 3091, as reported in the 118th  
Congress**

Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the  
following:

**1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Federal Law Enforce-  
3 ment Officer Service Weapon Purchase Act”.

**4 SEC. 2. PURCHASE OF RETIRED HANDGUNS BY FEDERAL  
5 LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 1 year after the  
7 date of enactment of this Act, the Administrator of Gen-  
8 eral Services shall establish a program under which a Fed-  
9 eral law enforcement officer may purchase a retired hand-  
10 gun from the Federal agency that issued the handgun to  
11 such officer.

12 (b) LIMITATIONS.—A Federal law enforcement offi-  
13 cer may purchase a retired handgun under subsection (a)  
14 if—

1           (1) the purchase is made during the six-month  
2           period beginning on the date the handgun was so re-  
3           tired; and

4           (2) with respect to such purchase, the officer is  
5           in good standing with the Federal agency that em-  
6           ploys such officer.

7           (c) COST.—A handgun purchased under this section  
8           shall be sold at the fair market value for such handgun  
9           taking into account the age and condition of the handgun.

10          (d) DEFINITIONS.—In this section—

11           (1) the term “Federal law enforcement officer”  
12           has the meaning given that term in section  
13           115(c)(1) of title 18, United States Code;

14           (2) the term “handgun” has the meaning given  
15           that term in section 921(a) of title 18, United  
16           States Code; and

17           (3) the term “retired handgun” means any  
18           handgun that has been declared surplus by the ap-  
19           plicable agency.
