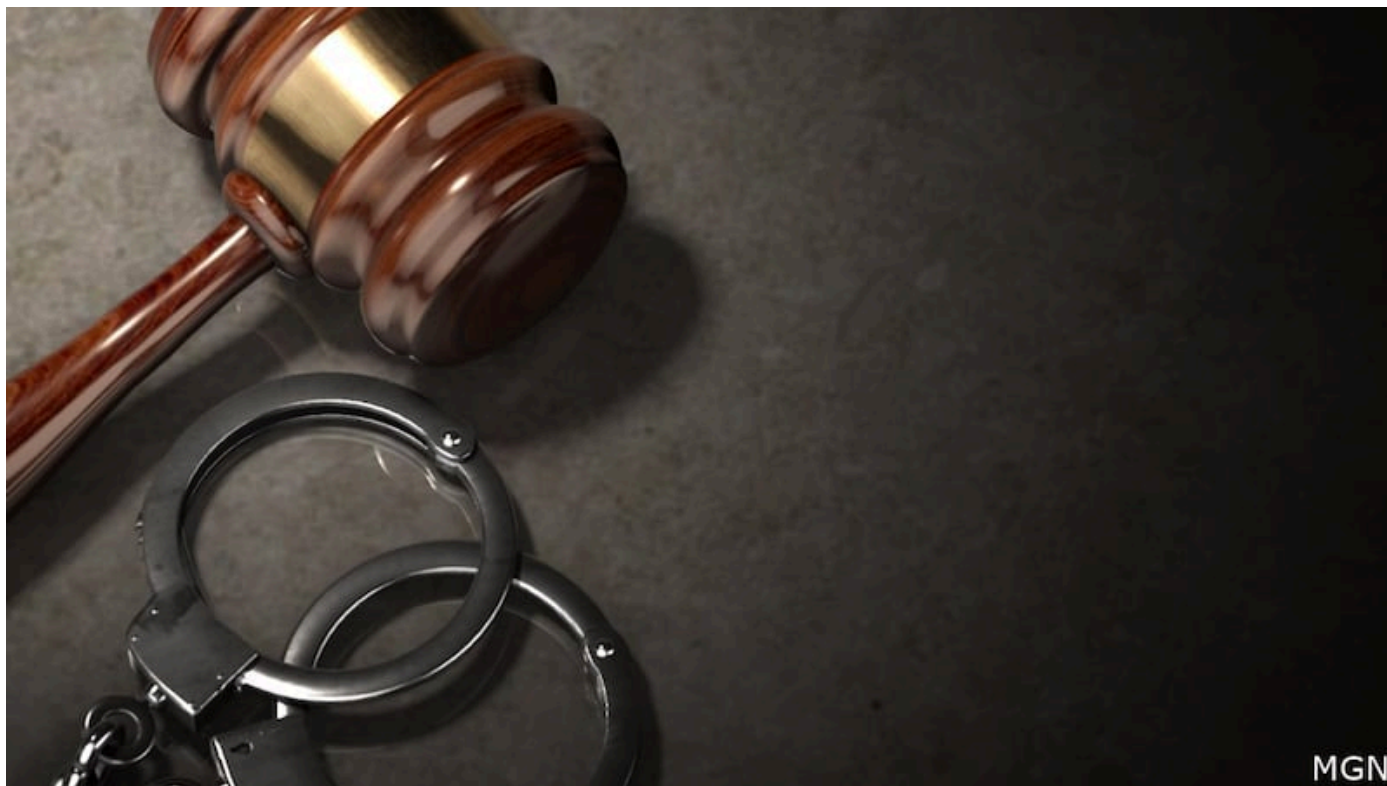


2 Arizona men accused of stealing over \$140K in Walmart theft scheme

PHOENIX (AZFamily)— The Arizona attorney general’s office announced that two men have been indicted in their role in an organized retail theft scheme targeting Walmart stores across the state.

Attorney General Kris Mayes said Alexander Moreno Dantzler and Christopher Campos-Henrey were indicted on 70 counts of organized retail theft and trafficking stolen property. Officials say the two stole from Walmart stores across Pima, Maricopa, Pinal, Cochise, Graham, Mohave, and Yavapai counties.

The two men stole over \$140,000 in merchandise from the stores. The indictment details the suspects stole Nintendo Switches, a PlayStation VR2, Xbox consoles, PlayStation 5 consoles, video games, cologne, headphones, an electric scooter, a Samsung soundbar, a smart TV and more.

The Pima County Sheriff’s Department, Oro Valley Police Department, Sahuarita Police Department and the Department of Public Safety assisted in the investigation.
