Sky News 1.	Tim Allan	Director of Communications for UK Prime Minister Keir Starmer	February 9, 2026	United Kingdom	Resigned following the departure of Chief of Staff Morgan McSweeney. Stated he wanted to allow “a new 10 team to be built” amid intense pressure and the ongoing PR crisis.
Fox News 2.	Morgan McSweeney	Chief of staff for PM Keir Starmer	February 8, 2026	United Kingdom	Resigned over the scandal around Peter Mandelson's appointment as UK ambassador to the US, despite his links to Epstein.
The Independent 3.	Mona Juul	Norway's ambassador to Jordan	February 8, 2026	Norway	Epstein left her children \$10 million in his will. Unclear if she received/accepted the funds. She and her husband have both claimed to have had a private relationship with Epstein that was unrelated to their official duties.

Jack Lang	Head of the Arab World Institute in Paris	February 7, 2026	France	France's Financial Prosecutor opened an investigation into Lang and his daughter(Caroline), on suspicion of " aggravated tax fraud laundering. " according to authorities. His name appears more than 600 times in files. 7 years of communication between him and JE until 2019.
BBC 5.	Ben Wegg-Prosser	Head of Global Counsel	February 6, 2026	United Kingdom	Emails show he expressed support to Epstein during his 2008 case. Internal report by JP Morgan suggests he stayed at Epstein's house shortly after Epstein's 2008 conviction. The report described the two as having a “particularly close relationship”. Photographed with JE on the

George Mitchell	Former U.S. Senator, honorary chair of the Mitchell Institute	February 6, 2026	USA	Court documents related to Epstein contain over 300 references to Mitchell and the two were in communication between 2010 and 2013. Epstein wanted to meet Mitchell multiple times between the same time period.
Politico 7.	Brad Karp	Chairman of Paul Weiss Law Firm	February 5, 2026	USA	Frequently attended Epstein's parties and stayed in contact until 2019 as shown by emails. When a woman demanded compensation for alleged wrong doing. Emails show Epstein and Karp trading notes about secret recordings, professional surveillance, and efforts to have the woman arrested for what Epstein described as an "extortion" attempt.

Ross	Department chair at the School of Visual Arts in New York and Former director of the Whitney Museum	February 3, 2026	USA	In one exchange in 2009, Epstein suggested an exhibition called "Statutory" that would feature "girls and boys ages 14-25 "where they look nothing like their true ages." Replied Ross: "You are incredible" and noted that Brooke Shields posed nude at age 10. Later that year, Ross wrote to console Epstein after the financier had been deposed. "Damn, this was not what you needed or deserved," Ross wrote. "I know how tough you are, and in fact, it probably bothers me as your friend more than it does you."
ABC 9.	Joanna Rubinstein	President of the Swedish UNHCR	February 2, 2026	Sweden	Rubinstein visited Epstein's private island with her family in 2012 and later thanked him in an email. At the time of the visit, Epstein had already been convicted of sex crimes.

Police raided two of Mandelson's properties on Friday as part of their investigation into misconduct in public office.

Lang said she resigned from that offshore company when further allegations were made against Epstein in 2019. Caroline Lang also appeared in Epstein's will as a beneficiary of €5m, according to the French investigative website Mediapart.
Politico 13.	Dean Kamen	FIRST (For Inspiration and Recognition of Science and Technology) Inventor of Segway and the first portable insulin pump	January 31st, 2026 *Did not resign. He was put on a <u>leave of absence</u> from his role at FIRST	USA	The DOJ release prompted Kamen's organizations to launch investigations into their ties. Claimed to have cut ties with Epstein, but communication persisted well past 2008 conviction. Visited Epstein's island In 2013 and was photographed with Epstein and Maxwell in a tropical location. <u>Assistants sent emails discussing</u> "which flight Dean prefers the girls to be on." Days later, <u>he wrote to Epstein</u> : "thank you for hosting an incredible visit to [sic] a magical place. It really is almost unbelievable."

Lajčák initially denied discussing women with Epstein when the files were released on Friday and claimed to resign to avoid damaging the Prime Minister politically.</p> <p>Lajčák said in 2018, "Regards from Kiev! Just to confirm that girls here are as gorgeous as ever:)" . In an exchange dated to 2018, he says, "Moscow has oil and girls" after Epstein writes that girls are "Moscow's best export".</p>

In one exchange, the former Treasury Summers asked for Epstein’s input on how to navigate a potential romantic relationship with a mentee. In another, Summers suggested women in aggregate have lower IQ than men.</p>

The two other allegations came from lawsuits filed, one of which was withdrawn and the other is still pending.</p>
