

Dr. Carol Swain embodies the American Dream. Born into abject poverty in rural Southwest Virginia as one of twelve children and a junior high dropout, she rose through unwavering determination to earn five advanced degrees: a B.A. magna cum laude in criminal justice from Roanoke College (Phi Beta Kappa founding member), a Ph.D. from UNC-Chapel Hill, and a Master of Studies in Law from Yale. She achieved early tenure at Princeton University and full professorship at Vanderbilt, serving as Professor of Political Science and Professor of Law.

A fierce defender of America, constitutional principles, and the rule of law, Dr. Swain is a leading expert on politics, race relations, immigration, and policy. The U.S. Supreme Court has cited her work three times. She has authored or edited over a dozen books—including titles from Cambridge and Harvard University Press—with her latest, *Diversity Without Discrimination: How to Promote a Culture of Unity in a Post-DEI/Affirmative Action World*. Appointed three times by U.S. Presidents, she served on the 1776 Commission, the National Endowment for the Humanities, and the Tennessee Advisory Committee to the U.S. Civil Rights Commission. In 2025, she received the Frederick Douglass Lifetime Achievement Award for her conservative service to the nation.

As an entrepreneur, Dr. Swain founded and leads Carol Swain Enterprises, LLC, and REAL Unity Training Solutions, providing innovative alternatives to divisive DEI programs that foster true unity, respect for civil rights, and equality under the law—ideal for law enforcement and public institutions seeking harmony and effectiveness. A frequent commentator on Fox News, CNN, ABC, CBS, and more, with op-eds in the *New York Times*, *Wall Street Journal*, and beyond, Dr. Swain inspires audiences with her courageous commitment to unity, constitutional values, and America's enduring promise.
