

AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE
TO H.R. 9834

Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the following:

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “No Racketeers on our
3 Shores Act of 2026”.

4 SEC. 2. INADMISSIBILITY AND DEPORTABILITY OF ALIENS
5 WHO ENGAGE IN ECONOMIC DISCRIMINA-
6 TION.

(a) INADMISSIBILITY.—Section 212(a)(2) of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1182(a)(2)) is amended by adding at the end the following:

“(J) ECONOMIC DISCRIMINATION.—Any alien who, while serving as a government official of any foreign government, initiates, directs, conducts, engages in, or issues one or more investigations, enforcement actions, licensing determinations, fines, fees, tax assessments, or other legal, regulatory, or administrative burdens against a United States person that are, individually or taken together, more severe,

1 more frequent, or less procedurally favorable
2 than those initiated, directed, conducted, en-
3 gaged in, or issued against a similarly situated
4 party that is not a United States person, is in-
5 admissible.”.

6 (b) DEPORTABILITY.—Section 237(a)(2) of the Im-
7 migration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1227(a)(2)) is
8 amended by adding at the end the following:

9 “(G) ECONOMIC DISCRIMINATION.—Any
10 alien who, while serving as a government offi-
11 cial of any foreign government, initiates, di-
12 rects, conducts, engages in, or issues one or
13 more investigations, enforcement actions, licens-
14 ing determinations, fines, fees, tax assessments,
15 or other legal, regulatory, or administrative
16 burdens against a United States person that
17 are, individually or taken together, more severe,
18 more frequent, or less procedurally favorable
19 than those initiated, directed, conducted, en-
20 gaged in, or issued against a similarly situated
21 party that is not a United States person, is de-
22 portable.”.
