During his career, Sheriff Hutchinson has served in multiple positions including; patrol, criminal investigations, POST certified defensive tactics, firearms, field training officer, and special operations instructor. Federally he served as a criminal and counter intelligence special agent, protective service detail leader, and a subject matter expert in force/asset protection within the DoD. Sheriff Hutchinson had the privilege to serve on a US Marshal Fugitive Taskforce, FBI Joint Terrorism Task Force, and deployed in support of the Global War on Terrorism. Sheriff Hutchinson is a proud graduate of Louisiana State University where he played football on a championship team and is an honor graduate of the Federal Law Enforcement Training Center and the National Sheriff's Institute at the FBI Academy.
