Judge Timothy Tymkovich, of Denver, Colorado, was nominated to the Tenth Circuit Court of Appeals by President George W. Bush and confirmed in April 2003. Since he has been on the court, he has served as Chief Circuit Judge, 2015-22; Chair of the US Judicial Conference's Committee on Judicial Resources, 2011-15; the Judicial Conference Workplace Conduct Working Group; Cybersecurity Task Force; and the Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Court of Review since November 2023. Since 2008 he has been an adjunct professor of law at the University of Colorado School of Law, teaching Election Law. He is a member of the Doyle Inn of Court, the American Law Institute, and the International Society of Barristers.
