Camille Cooper currently serves as Vice President of Anti Human Trafficking & Child Exploitation at the Tim Tebow Foundation. She brings over 20 years of experience in federal and state legislative drafting, strategizing, and lobbying on topics related to child protection, child exploitation, and anti-child trafficking. Camille has led efforts on over a dozen of the largest reforms on Capitol Hill and she has written and passed over fifty laws in twenty-four different states. Previously, Camille Cooper served as Vice President of Public Policy for an established anti-sexual assault nonprofit. Cooper's work for twenty years has focused on preventing the sexual abuse of children and combatting child exploitation crimes. As Director of Government Affairs for thirteen years at the National Association to Protect Children, a nonprofit organization dedicated to protecting children from abuse, neglect, and exploitation, her reforms have established the Department of Justice's National Strategy for Child Exploitation Prevention and Interdiction, provided over \$350 million of funding for state and local internet crimes against children task forces, established the HERO Child Rescue Corps, and the Domestic Trafficking Victims Fund at the Office of Justice Programs.
