Cody Wilde oversees Prison Fellowship's correctional programming in approximately 1,200 prisons across all 50 states. Cody began his time with Prison Fellowship in January of 2015, serving as an Academy director at the Lino Lakes Correctional Facility in Minnesota. He later served as a regional director for the Midwest and Great Lakes territory and as national director of operations for the Prison Fellowship Academy program.

Originally from North Dakota, Cody is a former officer in the United States Army and pastor of a church in St. Paul, MN. He received his undergraduate degree in history from Northwestern College in St. Paul, MN and holds graduate degrees in theology, international affairs, and business management from Bethel Seminary, The Bush School of Government at Texas A&M University and the Gies College of Business at the University of Illinois, Urbana-Champaign.
