

## BRETT J. FEDDERSEN Vice President, Strategy and Government Affairs

Brett Feddersen is the Vice President for Strategy and Governmental Affairs. He leads the company's strategy, public policy, and government relations and engages with U.S. government branches, policymakers, and regulators.

Previously, he was the CEO of Feddersen Group, specializing in national security and government relations, and President of AccelerātUM, where he advised on uncrewed mobility and aviation security advancements.

Before entering the private sector, Brett held key Senior Executive Service (SES) roles in the U.S. Government. He was the Executive Director for National Security Programs and Incident Response at the FAA, where he focused on intelligence, crisis management, and cybersecurity. At the Department of Defense, he developed strategies against transregional threats, including counterterrorism. While at the White House as the Director for Transportation and Border Security, he created a national framework for mitigating drone threats and issued a Presidential Executive Order to encourage domestic drone use while protecting privacy and civil liberties.

Mr. Feddersen has served in a variety of other high-profile executive assignments, including Senior Advisor to the Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff's efforts in Pakistan and Afghanistan, Special Assistant for Warfare to the Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense for Counter-Narcotics and Global Threats, and Senior Advisor to the Commander of the Combined Joint Special Operations Task Force in Afghanistan.

As an aviation and intelligence officer in the U.S. Army, Lieutenant Colonel Feddersen planned, executed, and led both ground and air combat operations in the Balkans, the Middle East, and Southwest Asia. Brett is an experienced air mission commander and pilot-in-command and has commanded Attack, Reconnaissance, and Air Assault units.

Mr. Feddersen began his career in public service as a Pennsylvania State Trooper with assignments as a patrol officer, undercover narcotics detective, homicide detective, and helicopter pilot in the Bureau of Emergency and Special Operations.

Mr. Feddersen holds a BS from Geneva College, an MS from Duquesne University, and Executive Certificates in Legislative Affairs from Georgetown University and Public Policy from Harvard University.
