

Dr. Ryan Wallace is a Professor at Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University. He holds an Ed.D. in Applied Education Studies, a M.S. in Aviation, and a B.S. in Aeronautics. His research focuses on UAS safety, security, human factors, and public policy. Dr. Wallace serves as the principal investigator for a portfolio of federal grants valued at more than \$10 million. He facilitated professional training seminars for federal agencies in the areas of UAS safety, operations, and counter-UAS topics. He serves as a representative on the FAA's Drone Safety Team. An Air Force veteran, he was a rated Air Battle Manager on the E-3 AWACS, where he accumulated more than 1,500 flight hours.
