Mr. McCleary is a co-founder of Keep Our Republic, a non-profit bipartisan civic organization focused on Presidential emergency powers and asymmetrical threats to the Republic. (keepourrepublic.com)

He was a White House Deputy Assistant to President Carter, where he oversaw an agency wide personnel and management review. He served as Treasure of the Democratic National Committee and sat on its National Executive Committee.

Mr. McCleary was President of Sawyer-Miller International, a leading international political and media consulting firm of its time. The firm ran presidential and prime minister campaigns in 15 countries plus developed strategic plans for international governments and companies such as Coca Cola, Goldman Sachs, and Apple.
