Nicole Neily is the president and founder of Parents Defending Education (PDE), a national membership organization that gives parents the resources and support they need to advocate for their children's education. PDE defends parents' rights in both courts of law and public opinion, and has successfully sued school districts and the US Department of Education in federal court; facilitated over 48,000 comments submitted to the Federal Register; filed 32 federal OCR complaints; and over 700 public records requests, including the FOIAs that exposed the National School Board Association's collusion with the Biden Administration.

Prior to launching PDE, Nicole created Speech First, a campus free speech organization that sued 6 public universities under her leadership; she has also worked as president of the Franklin Center for Government & Public Integrity, a state-level investigative journalism organization; as executive director and senior fellow at the Independent Women's Forum; and at the Cato Institute, where she created their department of external relations.
