James Rogers is Senior Counsel at America First Legal Foundation, where he litigates in border security, election integrity, parental rights, and constitutional and administrative law. Previously, he served as Senior Litigation Counsel in the Arizona Attorney General's Solicitor General's Office, where he led litigation challenging the Biden Administration's open-borders policies and COVID-19 vaccine mandates. Before that, he spent six years as a Foreign Service Officer at the U.S. Department of State, serving in the Office of the Assistant Legal Advisor for Consular Affairs and at U.S. diplomatic posts in Brazil and Namibia. Prior to government service, he was a commercial litigation partner at Osborn Maledon, a Phoenix-based firm ranked #1 in litigation by Chambers and Partners. He holds a J.D. from Harvard Law School, an LL.M. in International Law from the University of Cambridge, and a B.A. with honors in International Studies from Brigham Young University.
