Christopher Ferrara serves as Senior Counsel for Thomas More Society. In 1990, he founded the American Catholic Lawyers Association and joined Thomas More Society in 2020. Ferrara's legal work focuses on sanctity of life, religious liberty cases, and combatting unjust laws targeting Catholic institutions and infringing parental rights.

Christopher graduated from Fordham College in 1973 and Fordham Law in 1977 and is admitted to the bars of New York, New Jersey and South Carolina. He has been lead counsel in numerous reported decisions in state, federal, district, and circuit courts involving victories for pro-life advocates and other victims of deprivation of rights under the First Amendment. These victories include winning an
