

Witness Biography: Marco Hunter-Lopez
Subcommittee on the Constitution and Limited Government
“Sharia-Free America: Why Political Islam & Sharia Law are
Incompatible with the U.S. Constitution: Part II”

Marco Hunter-Lopez is a dedicated student leader, patriot, and civic activist from Wylie, Texas. A student at Wylie East High School, he has demonstrated exceptional commitment to public service, conservative principles, and community improvement at a young age. [REDACTED] Born and raised in Texas, Marco’s interest in politics was sparked through conversations with his grandmother. He has described feeling a strong calling to serve others and pursue a career in public office, with aspirations of one day running for Congress and contributing to national leadership. [REDACTED] He has been involved in national, state and local campaigns since the age of 13.

As a freshman at Wylie East High School, Marco founded and serves as president of the school’s Republican Student Club. He has also been involved with Turning Point USA (TPUSA) efforts. Despite facing challenges, including reported censorship from school administration, he has grown the club and hosted events featuring Texas Republican leaders. [REDACTED] Marco’s civic engagement includes serving on the PTA board. He coordinated with U.S. Congressman Keith Self to secure and donate a new 8-by-12-foot American flag to Burnett Junior High School, where he was previously a student. This initiative, part of a broader “Legacy Project,” included a Texas state flag donated by State Representative Candy Noble. The effort strengthened school pride and patriotism, culminating in a ceremony honoring the donations. [REDACTED]

In early 2026, Marco gained wider recognition for his principled stand on campus issues. As president of the Republican Student Club, he documented and publicly raised concerns about an unauthorized group distributing Islamic materials, including Qurans and hijabs, at Wylie East High School. His video and statements highlighted procedural concerns and sparked important community and media discussions about school policies. [REDACTED] Marco continues to build relationships with elected officials and community leaders while advocating for conservative values rooted in faith and service. His early accomplishments reflect strong leadership, initiative, and a deep commitment to American ideals.

Marco Hunter-Lopez represents the best of America’s rising generation—young citizens who actively engage in democracy, defend their communities, and pursue service with conviction. His story is one of promise, patriotism, and purposeful action.
