



Art Del Cueto served with the United States Border Patrol from 2003 to 2024, spending most of his career patrolling the Tohono O'odham reservation and assisting in major drug and smuggling investigations. A fluent Spanish speaker, he frequently led interviews with apprehended individuals and responded to critical incidents throughout the Tucson Sector.

Beyond his patrol duties, Mr. Del Cueto held elected leadership roles for more than a decade, serving as a spokesperson and advocate for agents at both the sector and national levels. He has testified before Congress, spoken at the White House, and addressed national audiences on border security issues.

Mr. Del Cueto has been featured on Fox News, CNN, Telemundo, Univision, Al Jazeera, and HBO's VICE. He also serves as a border security advisor to the Federation for American Immigration Reform and is on the board of advisors for Law Enforcement Today.
