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Mr. Mechkowski spent more than two decades with the Immigration and Naturalization Service and ICE, leading operations targeting transnational gangs, human traffickers, and other dangerous criminal offenders. He also served more than 30 years in the United States Army, bringing decades of frontline law enforcement and military experience to today's discussion.

He lives in New Jersey and currently serves as a Visiting Fellow for Deportation Studies at The Oversight Project, and in advisory roles at the National Immigration Center for Enforcement (NICE), and the Mass Deportation Coalition.
