



Fact Sheet: General Services Administration Resolution

Background Information

- Each year, the Administration submits to the Committee the General Services Administration (GSA) Capital Investment and Leasing Program (CILP) which includes prospectuses (project descriptions and justifications) for proposed projects that exceed a certain annual cost threshold (the FY2013 threshold is \$2.79 million; FY2014 threshold is \$2.85 million).
- The prospectuses are submitted pursuant to 40 U.S.C. 3307 and require approval by the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure and the Committee on Environment and Public Works in the Senate. The Committee approves the prospectuses through Committee resolution.

Summary

The Committee will take action on one GSA prospectus—

- **Auburn Federal Complex, Auburn, WA.** This prospectus was submitted as part of the FY2014 GSA CILP. The resolution would authorize \$17 million for repairs of Building 7 in the Auburn, Washington Federal Complex. These repairs are critical to address structural damage that resulted from severe snowstorms. Given the life safety concerns, this project is time sensitive.
