## A BILL

To amend the John F. Kennedy Center Act to authorize appropriations for the John F. Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “John F. Kennedy Cen-  
5 ter Reauthorization Act of 2015”.

6 **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

7 Section 13 of the John F. Kennedy Center Act (20  
8 U.S.C. 76r) is amended by striking subsections (a) and  
9 (b) and inserting the following:

1       “(a) MAINTENANCE, REPAIR, AND SECURITY.—

2 There is authorized to be appropriated to the Board to

3 carry out section 4(a)(1)(H)—

4           “(1) \$22,000,000 for fiscal year 2016;

5           “(2) \$24,000,000 for fiscal year 2017;

6           “(3) \$25,000,000 for fiscal year 2018;

7           “(4) \$25,000,000 for fiscal year 2019; and

8           “(5) \$26,000,000 for fiscal year 2020.

9       “(b) CAPITAL PROJECTS.—There is authorized to be

10 appropriated to the Board to carry out subparagraphs (F)

11 and (G) of section 4(a)(1)—

12           “(1) \$15,000,000 for fiscal year 2016;

13           “(2) \$13,000,000 for fiscal year 2017;

14           “(3) \$13,000,000 for fiscal year 2018;

15           “(4) \$14,000,000 for fiscal year 2019; and

16           “(5) \$14,000,000 for fiscal year 2020.”.
