At the end of subtitle F of title I of division B of the bill, add the following:

3 (a) PRIMARY AIRPORT APPORTIONMENT.—Section
4 47114(c)(1) of title 49, United States Code, is amended
5 by adding at the end the following:

6 "(J) COVID-19 EMERGENCY STABILIZA-7 TION.—

8	"(i) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding
9	subparagraph (A), the Secretary shall ap-
10	portion to a sponsor of an airport under
11	such subparagraph for each of fiscal years
12	2021 through 2023 an amount based on
13	the number of passenger boardings at the
14	airport during whichever of the following
15	years that would result in the highest ap-
16	portioned amount:
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- 18 "(II) Calendar year 2019.

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1	"(III) The calendar year prior to
2	the fiscal year in which the apportion-
3	ment occurs.
4	"(ii) Reduced apportionment.—
5	For each of fiscal years 2021 through
6	2023, any airport sponsor not subject to
7	subsection (f) in fiscal year 2020 shall not
8	be subject to subsection (f).".
9	(b) CARGO AIRPORT APPORTIONMENT.—Section
10	47114(c)(2) of title 49, United States Code, is amended
11	by adding at the end the following:
12	"(F) COVID-19 EMERGENCY STABILIZA-
13	TION.—Notwithstanding subparagraph (E), in
14	fiscal year 2022, landed weight under this para-
15	graph is the landed weight of aircraft landing
16	at each airport described in subparagraph (A)
17	during calendar year 2019.".
18	(c) NPIAS CLASSIFICATION.—Section 47114(d)(3)
19	is amended by adding at the end the following:
20	"(E) During fiscal years 2021 and 2022—
21	"(i) an airport that is newly listed as
22	having an unclassified status under the na-
23	tional plan of integrated airport systems
24	published in 2020 shall accrue apportion-
25	ment funds under subparagraph (A) at the

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1	same amount the airport accrued appor-
2	tionment funds in fiscal year 2020; and
3	"(ii) such apportionment shall not be
4	subject to the restrictions under section
5	47106(a)(7).".
6	(d) Contract Tower Program.—Notwithstanding
7	section 47124(d)(1)(B) of title 49, United States Code,
8	the Secretary of Transportation shall not calculate a ben-
9	efit-to-cost ratio with respect to an air traffic control tower
10	participating in the Contract Tower Program on the basis
11	of an annual aircraft traffic decrease—
12	(1) in calendar year 2020 or 2021; or
13	(2) in the 3 year period ending in calendar year
14	2020 or 2021.
15	(e) Immediate Applicability.—Section 1001 shall
16	not apply to this section and the amendments made by
17	this section.

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
