OFFERED BY MR. GARAMENDI OF CALIFORNIA

At the end of title III of division B of the bill, add the following:

I	SEC HIGHWAY SAFETY PROGRAMS REQUIREMENTS.
2	Section 402 of title 23, United States Code, as
3	amended by sections 3002 and 3003 of this title, is further
4	amended—
5	(1) in subsection (k) by striking paragraph (5)
6	and inserting the following:
7	"(5) Performance measures.—For highway
8	safety plans submitted under this subsection, the
9	performance measures required by the Secretary
10	under paragraph (4)(A) shall be limited to casualty
11	and crash rate improvements and those developed by
12	the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration
13	and the Governor's Highway Safety Administration
14	and described in the report, titled 'Traffic Safety
15	Performance Measures for States and Federal Agen-
16	cies' (DOT HS 811 025). The Secretary shall co-
17	ordinate with the Governor's Highway Safety Asso-
18	ciation in making revisions to the set of required
19	performance measures, consistent with the require-

1	ments for the consideration of grant allocations or
2	awards under subsection (o)."; and
3	(2) by adding at the end the following:
4	"(o) Additional Considerations and Require-
5	MENTS.—In allocating or awarding grants under this sec-
6	tion, the Secretary—
7	"(1) may require that States report information
8	to the Secretary regarding arrests, civil citations, or
9	tickets for violating traffic laws made or issued by
10	law enforcement officers under the jurisdiction of
11	the respective State;
12	"(2) may not consider any such information re-
13	ported under paragraph (1) in determining the com-
14	petitiveness of grant applications under this section
15	and
16	"(3) may require that States report information
17	to the Secretary regarding the aggregate number of
18	interventions made by law enforcement officers, in-
19	cluding such interventions that did not result in an
20	arrest or citation, under the jurisdiction of the re-
21	spective State and consider such information in de-
22	termining the competitiveness of any grant applica-
23	tions under this section.".
