(A) is identified as a nonmarket economy
country (as defined in section 771(18) of the
Tariff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C. 1677(18))) as of
the date of enactment of this subsection;

(B) was identified by the United States
Trade Representative in the most recent report
required by section 182 of the Trade Act of
1974 (19 U.S.C. 2242) as a foreign country in-

3	(C) is subject to monitoring by the Trade

6	(b) EXCEPTIONS.—
7	(1) IN GENERAL.—For purposes of paragraph
8	(1), the term "otherwise related legally or finan-
9	cially" does not include a minority relationship or in-

11	(2) PRODUCTS NOT AVAILABLE.—Subsection
12	(a) shall not apply if the steel product is not avail-
13	able at a reasonable price from a manufacturer that
