While PG&E is not primarily engaged in government contract or grant performance, it does provide utility services to over 3,000 federal government customer accounts in PG&E's service territory in Central and Northern California and performs other contracts, grants, and cooperative agreements. Most utility services are provided under PG&E's Area Wide Agreement with the General Services Administration (GS-00P-14-BSD-1137). Utility Energy Services Contracts are performed under that agreement for energy efficiency and resiliency improvements to federal facilities. PG&E also engages in federal grants and cooperative agreements on energy-related issues, such as smart grid demonstration.

PG&E has not identified any federal contracts or grants related to electric vehicles. This response is based on PG&E's information and belief following reasonable internal review and discussion. While PG&E has attempted to provide an accurate and complete response, PG&E has not conducted a detailed review of all federal contracts, grants, and cooperative agreements. Additional agreements or information may exist.
