2	BY RAIL.
3	(a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Transportation
4	may not issue any regulation or long-term order that—
5	(1) prohibits the transportation of methane, re-
6	frigerated liquid, commonly known as liquefied nat-
7	ural gas, by rail; or
8	(2) restricts or contracts the scope of allowance
9	provided by the final rule of the Pipeline and Haz-
10	ardous Materials Safety Administration, titled "Haz-
11	ardous Materials: Liquefied Natural Gas by Rail"
12	and published in the Federal Register on July 24,
13	2020 (85 Fed. Reg. 44994).
14	(b) RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.—Nothing in this sec-
15	tion shall be construed to limit the authority of the Sec-
16	retary of Transportation from issuing short-term emer-
17	gency orders related to the transportation of liquefied nat-
18	ural gas by rail.
