Jeff's experience includes playing a pivotal role as project manager and lead contact for owner and stakeholder relations on highly complex projects such as:

- I-5 Portland Avenue to Port of Tacoma Road NB HOV | WSDOT | Tacoma, WA | Design-Bid-Build | \$142M: This project widened I-5 from Portland Ave. to the Port of Tacoma Road and included construction of a new I-5 Puyallup River bridge (a nine-span 1,600-foot-long x 100-foot-wide precast girder bridge across the Puyallup River), construction of a four-span 820-foot-long x 40-foot-wide curved steel plate girder bridge for a new northbound off-ramp, reconstruction of the I-5/SR 167 interchange, and improvement of the Portland Ave. interchange.
- Interstate 5 Willamette River Bridge Replacement | ODOT | Eugene/Springfield, OR | CM/GC | \$148M: This project was the Oregon Department of Transportation's first CM/GC effort and the agency's largest project at the time. This project was delivered four months early and was \$12 million under budget with an excellent safety record. This project received extensive recognition as one of the best bridge projects in the country and won numerous awards, including the ENR 2014 Best of the Best Bridge/Hwy Division and 2014 AGC of America Build America Transportation.
- I-5 Kuebler Boulevard to N. Santiam Highway | ODOT | Salem, OR | Design-Bid-Build | \$52M: This project widened I-5 and constructed ten permanent bridges. The highlight of the project was accelerating the construction schedule and delivering the project on budget a year early.

Jeff's involvement as vice president has raised the bar for the industry's standard of excellence in honesty, quality, and collaboration, and has positioned him to be instrumental to the success of Hamilton.
