

**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE  
NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 5473  
OFFERED BY MR. LARSEN OF WASHINGTON**

Page 1, line 9, insert “, (f)(4),” after  
“(e)(1)(B)(iv)”.

Add at the end the following:

**1 SEC. 4. BUILDING CODE IMPLEMENTATION AND ENFORCE-**  
**2 MENT SET ASIDE.**

**3 (a) IN GENERAL.**—Section 203(f) of the Robert T.  
**4 Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act**  
**5 (42 U.S.C. 5133(f)) is amended by adding at the end the**  
**6 following:**

**7 “(4) BUILDING CODE IMPLEMENTATION AND**  
**8 ENFORCEMENT SET-ASIDE.—**

**9 “(A) IN GENERAL.**—Of the amounts made  
**10 available under this section for any given year,**  
**11 the President may use not less than 10 percent**  
**12 to carry out activities eligible under this section**  
**13 that further the implementation and enforce-**  
**14 ment of the latest published editions of relevant**  
**15 consensus-based codes, specifications, and**  
**16 standards, including any amendments made by**

1 State, local, Tribal, or territorial governments  
2 to such codes, specifications, and standards,  
3 that incorporate the latest hazard-resistant de-  
4 signs and establish minimum acceptable criteria  
5 for the design, construction, and maintenance  
6 of facilities and residential structures for which  
7 assistance may be available under this Act. In  
8 any fiscal year in which requests for assistance  
9 for such activities do not total at least 10 per-  
10 cent of amounts made available under this sec-  
11 tion, any remaining funds may be used as addi-  
12 tional assistance for the purposes of paragraph  
13 (1).

14 “(B) SUNSET.—The authority under this  
15 paragraph shall terminate on the date that is 8  
16 years after the date of enactment of this para-  
17 graph.”.

18 (b) APPLICABILITY.—The amendments made by this  
19 section shall only apply to amounts appropriated on or  
20 after the date of enactment of this Act.
