A BILL

To amend title 40, United States Code, to establish an expiration date of certain committee resolutions with respect to leases or projects, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LIMITATION ON AUTHORIZATIONS.**

4 Section 3307 of title 40, United States Code, is
5 amended by adding at the end the following:

6 “(i) EXPIRATION OF COMMITTEE RESOLUTIONS.—

7 “(1) IN GENERAL.—Unless a lease is awarded
8 or a construction, alteration, repair, design, or ac-
9 quisition project is initiated not later than 5 years

1 after the resolution approvals adopted by the Com-
2 mittee on Transportation and Infrastructure of the
3 House of Representatives or the Committee on Envi-
4 ronment and Public Works of the Senate pursuant
5 to subsection (a), such resolutions shall be deemed
6 expired.

7 “(2) APPLICATION.—This subsection shall only
8 apply to resolutions approved after the date of en-
9 actment of this subsection.”.
