

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 7070
OFFERED BY MR. PERRY OF PENNSYLVANIA

At the end of the bill, add the following:

1 SEC. 5. PROHIBITION ON USE OF FUNDS.

2 (a) PREDISASTER HAZARD MITIGATION.—Section
3 203 of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emer-
4 gency Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 5133) is amended by
5 adding at the end the following:

6 “(m) PROHIBITION.—The President may not provide
7 assistance under this section to a State that has not com-
8 pleted a wildfire management program that incorporates,
9 as appropriate, the principles of active management to fa-
10 cilitate wildfire prevention, suppression, and recovery
11 planning measures.”.

12 (b) HAZARD MITIGATION.—Section 404 of the Rob-
13 ert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance
14 Act (42 U.S.C. 5170e) is amended by adding at the end
15 the following:

16 “(h) PROHIBITION.—The President may not provide
17 assistance under this section to a State that has not com-
18 pleted a wildfire management program that incorporates,
19 as appropriate, the principles of active management to fa-

1 cilitate wildfire prevention, suppression, and recovery
2 planning measures.”.

3 (c) FIRE MANAGEMENT ASSISTANCE.—Section 420
4 of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency
5 Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 5187) is further amended by
6 adding at the end the following:

7 “(g) PROHIBITION.—The President may not provide
8 assistance under this section to a State that has not com-
9 pleted a wildfire management program that incorporates,
10 as appropriate, the principles of active management to fa-
11 cilitate wildfire prevention, suppression, and recovery
12 planning measures.”.
