(b) NO EFFECT ON LIABILITY.—A deeming under
subsection (a) shall have no effect on the liability of a responsible party under section 1002 of the Oil Pollution
Act of 1990 (33 U.S.C. 2702).

14 (c) COVERED VESSEL DEFINED.—In this section, the
15 term "covered vessel" means a vessel—

16 (1) that is determined to be abandoned pursu17 ant to section 4711 of title 46, United States Code;
18 and

(2) for which there is no removal authority
 under section 311(c) of the Federal Water Pollution
 Control Act (33 U.S.C. 1321(c)).
