At the end of section 100001, add the following:

(j) REPORTS ON BORDER SECURITY ACTIVITIES OF
 THE COAST GUARD.—

3 (1) IN GENERAL.—With respect to any amounts 4 made available under this section to the Coast 5 Guard for the purposes of conducting border secu-6 rity activities directed by the Department of Homeland Security, the Commandant of the Coast Guard 7 shall submit to the Committee on Transportation 8 9 and Infrastructure of the House of Representatives 10 and the Committee on Commerce, Science, and 11 Transportation of the Senate a report for each oc-12 currence in which—

13 (A) the border security activities degrade
14 the capability of the Coast Guard to conduct
15 search and rescue efforts; and

16 (B) the degradation described in subpara-17 graph (A) result in death or loss at sea.

18 (2) CONTENTS.—The report in paragraph (1)19 shall contain, at a minimum—

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1	(A) an accounting of all assets and per-
2	sonnel deployed to border security activities at
3	the time of the search and rescue effort, and
4	any resulting force laydown posture;
5	(B) a summary of the search and rescue
6	case;
7	(C) a description of the efforts undertaken
8	by the Coast Guard to respond, to include all
9	mobilized assets and requests for assistance,
10	tasked to other government agencies or non-
11	governmental entities or individuals; and
12	(D) response times for each asset tasked to
13	conduct search and rescue efforts.
14	(3) SUBMISSION TO CONGRESS.—At the end of
15	each fiscal year in which amounts described in para-
16	graph (1) are made available, the Commandant of
17	the Coast Guard shall submit to the Committee on
18	Transportation and Infrastructure of the House of
19	Representatives and the Committee on Commerce,
20	Science, and Transportation of the Senate a report
21	that—
22	(A) contains each report required under
23	this subsection and any other incidents not pre-
24	viously reported that would be required under
25	this subsection;

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(B) provides an analysis of what actions
 could have been taken if assets had not been
 deployed to conduct border security activities;

 (C) recommendations regarding future

(C) recommendations regarding future asset coverage that would not degrade the search and rescue capabilities of the Coast Guard.

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
