

**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE
NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 4275
OFFERED BY MR. GRAVES OF MISSOURI**

Redesignate the second titles I and II and titles III through V as titles III through VII, respectively.

Page 9, before line 1, insert the following (and designate the subsequent subparagraphs accordingly):

1 “(A) \$1,147,244,000 for fiscal year
2 2025;”.

Page 30, after line 15, insert the following:

3 **SEC. 118. ANNUAL PLAN FOR COAST GUARD OPERATIONS**
4 **IN THE PACIFIC.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 51 of title 14, United
6 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
7 lowing:

8 **“§ 5116. Annual plan for Coast Guard operations in**
9 **the Pacific**

10 “(a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than December 31,
11 2025, and annually thereafter, the Commandant of the
12 Coast Guard, in consultation with the Secretary of State
13 and Secretary of Defense, shall submit to the appropriate
14 congressional committees a plan for Coast Guard oper-

1 ations in the Pacific region for the year after the year
2 during which the plan is submitted. Such plan shall in-
3 clude, for the year covered by the plan, each of the fol-
4 lowing elements:

5 “(1) A list of objectives for Coast Guard en-
6 gagement in the Pacific region in support of Depart-
7 ment of State and Department of Defense missions.

8 “(2) An assessment of the capabilities of the
9 Coast Guard to support Department of State and
10 Department of Defense missions in the Pacific re-
11 gion.

12 “(3) A list of any areas in the Pacific region
13 where an increased Coast Guard presence would bet-
14 ter support Department of State and Department of
15 Defense missions.

16 “(4) The projected demand for Coast Guard en-
17 gagement in the Pacific region from the Department
18 of State and the Department of Defense for the year
19 covered by the plan and the subsequent 10 years.

20 “(5) An assessment of whether the Coast
21 Guard will be able to meet such projected demand
22 for the year covered by the plan, including—

23 “(A) a list of any factors limiting the abil-
24 ity of the Coast Guard to meet such projected
25 demand; and

1 “(B) an analysis of the location from
2 which any Coast Guard assets used to carry out
3 missions in the Pacific, in addition to assets
4 available in the year prior to the year in which
5 the plan is submitted, will be transferred and
6 any associated gaps in Coast Guard mission
7 coverage any such transfers will create.

8 “(6) A summary of the resources needed for the
9 Coast Guard to meet such projected demand for the
10 year covered by the plan, including—

11 “(A) staff;

12 “(B) infrastructure, including shore infra-
13 structure;

14 “(C) administrative and logistical support;
15 and

16 “(D) technology.

17 “(7) Any other matter as determined relevant
18 by the Commandant.

19 “(b) FORM.—Each plan under subsection (a) shall be
20 submitted in unclassified form, but may include a classi-
21 fied annex.

22 “(c) BRIEFING REQUIRED.—Not later than February
23 15, 2026, and annually thereafter, the Commandant shall
24 provide to the appropriate congressional committees a

1 briefing on the annual plan required under subsection (a)
2 submitted during the preceding year.

3 “(d) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES
4 DEFINED.—In this section, the term ‘appropriate congress-
5 sional committees’ means—

6 “(1) the Committee on Transportation and In-
7 frastructure of the House of Representatives;

8 “(2) the Committee on Appropriations of the
9 House of Representatives;

10 “(3) the Committee on Armed Services of the
11 House of Representatives;

12 “(4) the Committee on Commerce, Science, and
13 Transportation of the Senate;

14 “(5) the Committee on Appropriations of the
15 Senate; and

16 “(6) the Committee on Armed Services of the
17 Senate.

18 **“§ 5117. Annual budget display for Coast Guard oper-**
19 **ations in the Pacific**

20 “(a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than February 15,
21 2026, and annually thereafter, the Commandant of the
22 Coast Guard shall submit to the appropriate congressional
23 committees a detailed budget display for Coast Guard op-
24 erations in the Pacific region for the fiscal year after the
25 fiscal year during which the budget display is submitted.

1 The Commandant shall base such budget display on the
2 projected demand for Coast Guard engagement in the Pa-
3 cific region as identified in the most recent annual plan
4 developed under section 5116 of this title. Such budget
5 display shall include, for the year covered by the budget
6 display, the following information:

7 “(1) With respect to procurement accounts,
8 amounts displayed by account, budget activity, line
9 number, line item, and line item title.

10 “(2) With respect to research, development,
11 test, and evaluation accounts, amounts displayed by
12 account, budget activity, line number, program ele-
13 ment, and program element title.

14 “(3) With respect to operation and maintenance
15 accounts, amounts displayed by account title, budget
16 activity title, line number, and subactivity group
17 title.

18 “(4) With respect to military personnel ac-
19 counts, amounts displayed by account, budget activ-
20 ity, budget subactivity, and budget subactivity title.

21 “(b) FORM.—Each display under subsection (a) shall
22 be submitted in unclassified form, but may include a clas-
23 sified annex.

24 “(c) BRIEFING REQUIRED.—Not later than February
25 15, 2026, and annually thereafter, the Commandant shall

1 provide to the appropriate congressional committees a
2 briefing on the budget display required by subsection (a)
3 for the fiscal year after the fiscal year during which the
4 briefing is provided.

5 “(d) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES
6 DEFINED.—In this section, the term ‘appropriate congres-
7 sional committees’ has the meaning given such term in
8 section 5116.”.

9 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The analysis for chap-
10 ter 51 of title 14, United States Code, is amended by add-
11 ing at the end the following:

“5116. Annual plan for Coast Guard operations in the Pacific.

“5117. Annual budget display for Coast Guard operations in the Pacific.”.

Page 94, line 12, strike “\$2,000,000” and insert
“\$4,000,000”.

Page 117, after line 15, insert the following:

12 **SEC. 236. ENTITY OTHER THAN THE COAST GUARD.**

13 Notwithstanding section 1105(a) of title 14, United
14 States Code, the Commandant may provide for an entity
15 other than the Coast Guard to contract for the acquisition,
16 procurement, or construction of—

17 (1) the Arctic Security Cutters for which funds
18 were appropriated under section 40001 of Public
19 Law 119–21; and

1 (2) all other vessels for which funds were ap-
2 propriated under section 40001 of Public Law 119–
3 21.

Page 200, after line 25, insert the following:

4 **SEC. 283. REPORT ON EAST ROCKAWAY INLET NAVIGATION.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days after the
6 date of enactment of this Act, the Commandant shall sub-
7 mit to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastruc-
8 ture of the House of Representatives and the Committee
9 on Commerce, Science, and Transportation of the Senate
10 a report of the navigable waterway of the East Rockaway
11 Inlet located on Long Island, New York.

12 (b) CONTENTS.—The report under subsection (a)
13 shall include—

14 (1) an evaluation of potential hazards to navi-
15 gation present in the East Rockaway Inlet;

16 (2) a map of current and future aids to naviga-
17 tion in the East Rockaway Inlet;

18 (3) an evaluation of the effects of the current
19 channel hazards on commercial navigation and safe-
20 ty;

21 (4) recommendations on addressing hazards to
22 navigation present in the East Rockaway Inlet; and

23 (5) recommendations on updates to the nec-
24 essary to aids navigation in order to maintain safety.

Page 235, beginning on line 19, strike “amended” and all that follows through “striking” on line 22, and insert “amended by striking”.

Page 236, line 4, strike “180” and insert “90”.

Page 245, line 4, strike the closing quotation marks and the second period.

Page 245, after line 4, insert the following:

1 “(J) National labor unions representing
2 longshore workers.”.

Strike page 277, line 3 through page 310, line 19.

After section 350 insert the following:

3 **SEC. 351. BRIEFING ON DEPLOYMENT OF SPECIAL PUR-**
4 **POSE CRAFT – HEAVY WEATHER SECOND**
5 **GENERATION (SPC-HWX II) VESSELS IN PA-**
6 **CIFIC NORTHWEST.**

7 Not later than 180 days after the date of enactment
8 of this Act, the Commandant shall provide to the Com-
9 mittee on Commerce, Science, and Transportation of the
10 Senate and the Committee on Transportation and Infra-
11 structure of the House of Representatives a briefing on—
12 (1) the status of the acquisition and procure-
13 ment of second-generation Special Purpose Craft –
14 Heavy Weather (SPC–HWX II) vessels;

- 1 (2) the timeline for the deployment of such ves-
- 2 sels to stations in the Pacific Northwest previously
- 3 served by the first-generation Special Purpose Craft
- 4 – Heavy Weather vessels; and
- 5 (3) any outstanding barriers to the timeliness of
- 6 such deployment.
