The Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure met at 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, June 4, 2026, in 2167 Rayburn House Office Building, pursuant to notice, in an open session, with a quorum present, and considered the following measures:

- Approval of updated Subcommittee Rosters due to changes on the Majority side;
- The Fiscal Year 2027 Views and Estimates of the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure;
- General Services Administration Capital Investment and Leasing Program Resolution; and
- Other matters cleared for consideration.

The Committee took the following actions:

The Committee approved the updated Subcommittee Rosters due to changes on the Majority side by unanimous consent.

Fiscal Year 2027 Views and Estimates of the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure; was ADOPTED and ordered to be transmitted to the Committee on the Budget by voice vote.

A motion by Chairman Graves that, pursuant to House Rule X, clause 4, the Fiscal Year 2027 Views and Estimates of the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure be adopted and submitted to the Committee on the Budget; was NOT OBJECTED TO.

General Services Administration Capital Investment and Leasing Program Resolution: GSA Resolution, Alteration, 1800 F. Street Federal Building, Washington, DC, PDC-0021-WA26; was AGREED TO by voice vote.
