Kevin Robert Perry is a registered landscape architect in Oregon and an internationally recognized leader in successfully integrating stormwater management with high-quality urban design. For nearly two decades, Mr. Perry has worked on over 90 green infrastructure projects throughout North America within the public, private, and academic sectors. He has received multiple national and regional awards for his work in green infrastructure and was elevated as a Fellow of the American Society of Landscape Architects in 2017.

Mr. Perry is a Senior Landscape Architect with *Toole Design Group* advancing the effort to intertwine green infrastructure within innovative multimodal streetscape design throughout the west coast and nationally. Kevin Robert Perry is also the founder of *Urban Rain Design*; a small design studio specializing in using *Tactical Green Infrastructure* to rapidly implement simple, cost-effective, and beautiful green infrastructure demonstration projects within public realm sites.

Kevin Robert Perry received his bachelor's degree in Landscape Architecture in 1996 at the University of California, Davis. He has now come full circle and selectively teaches studio design courses in green infrastructure at the UC Davis Department of Landscape Architecture. In addition, Mr. Perry founded the *California Student Leadership in Green Infrastructure* at UC Davis and has since expanded this student volunteer group to other university campuses throughout the state.
