Radhika Fox serves as Assistant Administrator for Water at the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. She was confirmed to this position on a bi-partisan vote by the U.S. Senate on June 16, 2022. As Assistant Administrator, Mrs. Fox is committed to centering water as a solution to the challenges facing communities across the country. She is using her 20+ years of experience to address the most salient water issues at EPA's Office of Water.

Prior to joining EPA, Mrs. Fox served as Chief Executive Officer for the U.S. Water Alliance, Director for Policy and Government Affairs for the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission, and Federal Policy Director at PolicyLink. Mrs. Fox is a longstanding leader in the water sector and is the first Assistant Administrator with public utility experience, the first woman of color and the first person of Asian heritage to lead Office of Water.
